

Fundscrip Tuition Fundraising



Saving money for tuition can be tough. That is why we have partnered up with a national gift card fundraising group called Fundscrip to help our families build a savings account for their children's future CCS tuition.

What is Fundscrip?

FundScrip is an established, Canada-wide fundraising program which gives people the opportunity to purchase gift cards (groceries, gas, home & garden, entertainment, restaurants, and much more) through their organization (CCS) with a percentage of that gift card balance bumped back to the purchaser's account. The office keeps track of the percentages earned and will let families know how much goes towards next year's tuition at the end of the year.

How can I make an order?

Placing an order can be done several ways:

- Email the office with your order and it will be placed for you. Please include the name of the stores you would like to order for as well as the dollar value and quantity of cards you would like to order. Payment would need to be e-transferred to payables@ccsmj.ca. This must be done before noon on Wednesdays.
- Sign up at fundscrip.com. The CCS code is **7D7JNV**. There you can place an order and e-transfer the payment to CCS at payables@ccsmj.ca. This must be done before noon on Wednesdays.
- Sign up at fundscrip.com and also sign up for EFT so that money can be debited directly from your account when the order is processed. This way of ordering allows you to place the order Wednesday evenings.

When will I receive my gift card orders?

At CCS we do bi-weekly Fundscrip orders. Week one is order week with the orders arriving on the Tuesday or Wednesday of the following week. Orders can be sent home with students or picked up at the CCS office.

Can family members ALSO order gift cards with the benefits going to my family's account?

Yes! Family members can also order the same way as listed above. Upon ordering, family members will be advised of when to pick the gift cards order up. If family members live out of town and would like to help out, they can sign up at Fundscrip.com, pay for the cards by EFT with Fundscrip and have their cards shipped directly to them. Non direct family members need to indicate to the office who they would like the benefit to go to so that your account will be credited.
