Program

The candidate will design the Cornerstone Preschool program to focus on the development of the whole child—physical, social, emotional, cognitive, and spiritual. The candidate will develop a program that reflects deep developmental understanding of preschool children so that the students experience active, experiential learning through play. The goals of the learning activities will help children develop language and communication skills; develop problem-solving skills; learn to co-operate with others; and make new friendships. Activities will also include character lessons based on biblical values in order to support the Christian faith within the home and church and to help the children make sense of the complicated world in which they live.

Duties

Design and implement programming based on Play and Exploration Early Learning Program Guide as developed by the SK Ministry of Education.

Qualifications & Skills:

- A Bachelor of Education degree from an accredited university or at a minimum a two year Early Childhood Educator diploma (ECE Level III certification)
 - Individuals with post-secondary training in the fields of psychology, nursing, long term care, educational assistant, social work, and other related social sciences or health care fields often have education and training that may be equivalent or transferable to credentials for Early Childhood Certification and are encouraged to apply.
- A satisfactory criminal record check and vulnerable sector check must be provided prior to commencement of employment.
- Valid and current CPR and First Aid Certificates including child cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- Knowledge of early learning regulations in the province of Saskatchewan
- Assess the developmental level of children
- Prepare progress reports and discuss with parents and other staff members
- Provide supervision and guidance of daily activities, field trips and special activities
- Provide opportunity for creative expression through the mediums of art, dramatic play and music

A pastoral reference and two other references must be included with the resume. Applications that do not have a pastoral reference letter will not be considered.
